Here we are submitting you a Brief activity report of project during 2021-22

Educational:

As we all know that the pandemic of COVID-19 impacted the whole world very badly in every sector. But for the education sector it came like a big disaster, especially for children of primary classes as for them the physical classes remain closed for almost 18 months.

School is not a place for study only but a place for their overall development. They come to school to learn to make friends, to learn having and sharing the things like lunch, toys, work books etc. including culture and nature.

They learn to handle the various situation independently

During the Covid-19 period they had been pushed in homes with mobile phones and internet based education Or we can say they had been left with technology. As a result a major change in the behavior of young children is being noticed. They are being not only lazy but stubborn also. They became edict of mobile phones, YouTube, WhatsApp and other apps of like that. We don't know it's good or not for their future but lets hope for positive.

On the other hand, a material number of drop out has been noticed in older children due to change in financial and social situation of families.

As there was no another option, to keep the students connected with school and education, online classes were started which was run up to September organized for all students. Ofcourse the result of these classes was not much good due to lac of smart phones, laptop, computer and much internet data. But it helped us to keep the students and parents connected with school.

After 2nd wave to Corona virus educational institutions were reopen by government with many restrictions and under the Covid-19 protocol from September . Initially with school were open for older students with 50% capacity. Later on step by step for all classes including primary classes. Now schools are running normally.

Admission Process;

The new admission process was started in August 2021 but in the beginning it was not in normal way as the parents were bit confused with opening of school also they were afraid with Corona virus.

Our staff visited to the houses of most of the students & in the area and try to convince them. On the other hand day by day the situation of Covid-19 became normal and life started to come on the track.

Now the admission work had been complete in all schools. Some drop outs have been reported in every school. In completion the admission work in time and maintaining the number of students in our schools, the online classes played an important role. If we compare in this way then the decision of online classes was fruitful.

Examination :

In the changed educational situation of Covid-19, the assessment pattern has been changed. Students are being evaluated on the monthly basis.

Two monthly assessments (October and November) are already complete and today the Half Yearly examination has been complete. Now staff will complete the examination records.

From 25th December to 31st December, there will be Christmas Holidays.



Covid Protocol :

In all our Institutions, government guidelines and corona protocol is being followed as much as possible.

Automatic sanitizer machines had been installed on the main entry of every institution and everyone entering the campus has to be sanitize his/her hand. Thermal scanning is also necessary for students, teachers and visitors.

Wearing a face mask is necessary for students, staff and visitors. No MASK – NO ENTRY policy is being followed strictly.

We are trying to maintain the social distancing also. Sharing the things like water bottles, lunch box, work book etc is also not allowed. Now students are also quite aware about this thing.

Prayer/morning assembly is also not being organized.

Technical School:

Like formal educational Institutions, technical Institution are also had very bed impact of Corona. Last year in 2020-21 the session couldn't not complete and as a result, in last week the practical examinations were organized by government and the final written examination will be organize in January 2021.

On the other side admission process for session 2021-22 is in process and the last date is 31 December 2021. The date of admission has been extended by government already 4 times as there were not enough students in ITI Institutions (Neither government nor Pvt.).

Free Stitching course for women:

To motivate the women/ Girls toward stitching course, a 15 days basis stitching course has been started.

Hope it will be helpful to get admission in sewing technology trade.

Other Activities:

Mission Happiness:

In same way like last year, Grocery kits were provided to whole staff up to month of September as an extra help to their families. Afterwards regular full time school was started, so there was no need to provide it.

The whole staff is really very happy and thankful to Opus III for this extra help in endemic period.



Co-Sponsor for FCS 2 School:

There are total 267 students in Fun and Child School No.2. In total 140 Boys and 127 girls.

Out of it 60 students (25 Boys & 35 Girls) are being sponsored by an Italian Sponsor "HANG LOOSE SRL" with name 'Keep out of love school Jaipur'.

Therefore in FCS 2 total 207 students (115 Boys and 92 Girls) are sponsored by Opus III.

Vaccination Camp:

Government is trying their level best to vaccinate everyone against Corona Virus but being a country with huge population it's not an easy task. It needs time. Many social organizations are also helping the government to motivate and to vaccinate the people.

We are also working in this field. With a local women group in FCS 4 area two vaccination camps have been organized. The first one on dated 08.10.2021 and second one was organized today in the campus of Fun and Child School No. 4

The response of people was quite good and community is happy with this effort. Both camps were organized in the supervision of Mr. Rajendra Kumawat (Treasurer, DSWS)



Medical:

The medical activities in hospital are running on regular basis. Dr. Om is providing his voluntary services as always. Even in both the lockdown period our hospital was functioning in normal way and the services of doctor, laboratory and pharmacy was available to the people of Hasanpura. It's really a matter of great pleasure for us that we could provide the community a service of professional medical team.

People of Hasanpura are very happy with it.

Deepawali Celebration :

Deepawali, the festival of lights was celebrated with full of joy and happiness.



The festival was organized in the campus of DPS with whole team of staff members. Good wishes Greeting cards were given to all staff members. These cards were prepared by students & teacher of Drawing faculty of DPS.

There are total 26 animals in Dairy; 24 buffalo, 1 male buffalo and one Cow.
